

Trinity Farm's Barn Rules

1. Farm is open from 8:00 am to 7:00 pm only. Boarders are only permitted to ride during the stated hours unless otherwise approved by the farm owner.
2. No one is allowed to mount any horse unless they have filled out and signed a liability release.
3. Schooling over fences is permitted only under the direct supervision of an instructor/trainer. Please do not adjust the location of the jumps without permission.
4. If you turn a light on, turn it off when you are finished using that area. The lights in the arena may **ONLY** be turned on when it is dark and they must be turned off immediately as you leave the ring. Arena lights must be off by 7 pm; which is the time that this farm closes.
5. No smoking in or near the barn. All cigarettes will be fully extinguished and disposed of in the proper location.
6. Keep the aisle clean of tack, brushes, halters, hoof picks, and/or manure. *If you or your horse put it there, pick it up!*
7. All vehicles and horse trailers must be parked in the designated parking areas.
8. No visitors are allowed in the stalls. Boarders may retrieve their horses from the stalls and properly tie them for visitors to view.
9. No visitors are allowed in the pasture. Boarders may enter the pasture to retrieve **ONLY** the owner's equine.
10. Owners may not handle any equine other than their own or an animal they have leased.
11. Do not feed your equine. If you believe your equine needs its rations increased, please notify the farm owner. Feeding your equine outside of the habitual feeding period can cause colic in your equine as well as in those equines around yours which are not being fed at the same time.
12. Do not give treats to any equine other than your own unless written permission is on file with the farm. Some equines may have stomach problems associated with some treats.
13. Do not ride without safety equipment. The farm will not be held responsible for any injury, accident and/or death occurring because you failed to use the proper safety equipment.

HELMETS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED.

14. Do not ride on properties not designated as allowed riding areas. The farm will not be held responsible for any injury, accident and/or death occurring because you failed to stay on proper trails, fields or roads. The farm will not be responsible for any fines and/or jail terms for trespassing on posted or non-posted properties.
15. Always mount and dismount outside. Do not ride your horse in the barn.
16. No running or yelling in the barn or surrounding areas, especially when horses are

present. The farm cannot be responsible for any injury, accident and/or death associated with scaring or spooking an equine due to inappropriate behavior or misbehavior.

17. Do not tie your horse with your reins. All horses are to be tied in the aisles with a lead rope or in the grooming stall with the cross ties while wearing a serviceable halter. The farm will not be responsible for any injury, accident and/or death associated with tying your horse with the reins, or bailing twine or any other inappropriate equipment.
18. Always check your tack before riding. The farm will not be responsible for the quality of repair of your tack and will not be held responsible for any injury, accident and/or death associated with using tack in ill repair.
19. All injuries, accidents and damages must be immediately brought to our attention. Any unreported incidents will be the responsibility of the boarder or leasor.
20. After washing your horse, please make sure the water is turned off, manure is picked up, and replace the hose as you found it.
21. Please clean up after yourself in the break room. Wash your dishes or put them in the dishwasher. Wipe up any spills or splatters in the microwave.
22. Turn off the television and the lights when you leave the break room.
23. Do NOT adjust the temperature settings on any thermostat.
24. Please do not help yourself to anyone's food, drinks, tack, or any other personal belongings without permission.
25. All horses need to be in a secure location at all times. Allowing a horse to roam freely is not permitted.
